

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

REUNION 2010

The Tulane Medical Alumni Association will present several awards in conjunction with Reunion 2010, which will be held in the Fall of 2010. Additionally, the lifetime achievement award will be presented at the 50th Reunion in May 2010. The awards and criteria are as follows:

OUTSTANDING ALUMNUS AWARD

Recognizes career accomplishments and/or excellence in the medical profession.

- Must be a graduate of the Tulane University School of Medicine for at least 10 years prior to being a nominee for the award;
- Must be distinguished in his/her profession, and must have received previous recognition from peers.

DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

Recognizes demonstrated loyalty and/or service to Tulane University School of Medicine.

- Must be an individual whose interest and loyalty to the school is evident;
- Must have had active role in supporting the school since the time of graduation.

C.D. TAYLOR AWARD

Recognizes outstanding service to the medical health of one's community by significant work with individuals and/or organizations within the community.

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

(Available only to the 50-year graduating class - M'60)

Recognizes an alumnus/a whose life has been an exemplary one. The individual may have made significant contributions to the field of medicine, offered outstanding leadership in his/her community, exhibited an unusual degree of dedication and/or service to Tulane, or any combination of the above.

Please observe the following guidelines when making a nomination:

1. Any member of the faculty or alumni body may make a nomination.
2. Recipient must be willing and able to be present at the event that the award is presented.
3. Nominations must consist of:
 - A) A comprehensive cover letter stating why the nominee is deserving of the award; and
 - B) Contact information (telephone and/or email address) for nominee.

For the service award, the cover letter should highlight service activities. Supporting documents are encouraged.

The deadline for nominations is: March 1, 2010.
